On December 27, 2018, Five Star Senior Living Inc., or the Company, entered into a letter agreement with Mr. R. Scott Herzig, the Company s former Senior Vice President of Senior Living Operations, regarding the terms and conditions of the termination of his employment. The Company previously reported the termination of Mr. Herzig s employment in the Company s Current Report on Form 8-K dated December 11, 2018. Pursuant to the letter agreement, among other things, Mr. Herzig will receive a cash payment from the Company of \$510,000 in January 2019, subject to conditions. The letter agreement also contains standard restrictive covenants relating to non-competition, confidentiality and non-solicitation of employees.
