Once earned, the PSUs vest and are paid through the issuance of shares of Common Stock in four approximately equal annual installments commencing on or about May 1, 2011, 2012, 2013 and 2014, subject to the reporting person's continued employment or association with the Issuer on the date such shares of Common Stock are to be issued.
- A Restricted Share Unit, sometimes referred to as a Restricted Stock Unit or RSU, represents the conditional right to receive one share of Common Stock. RSUs granted in April 2011 resulted in the right to receive 6,000 shares of Common Stock. The RSUs vest and are paid through the issuance of shares of Common Stock in four approximately equal annual installments commencing on or about May 1, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015, subject to the reporting person's continued employment or association with the Issuer on the date such shares of Common Stock are to be issued.
