- (1) On May 25, 2005, the common stock of the Issuer split 2-for-1, resulting in the reporting person's acquisition of 24,394 additional shares of common stock.

- (2) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 20,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. This option was previously reported as covering 10,000 shares at an exercise price of \$38.03 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 2/09/2002.

- (3) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 18,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. This option was previously reported as covering 9,000 shares at an exercise price of \$33.73 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 2/07/2003.

- (4) Part of a grant to the reporting person of 15,000 shares from the Issuer's 2000 Stock Plan. This option was previously reported as covering 7,500 shares at an exercise price of \$32.50 per share, but was adjusted to reflect the stock split on May 25, 2005. The options vest(ed) in five equal annual installments beginning 8/14/2003.
