On March 20, 2006, Triarc Companies, Inc. (the "Company") announced that the trustee under the Indenture (the "Indenture") governing the Company's 5% Convertible Notes due 2023 (the "Notes") has determined that holders of the Notes are entitled to convert their Notes during the fiscal quarter beginning on April 3, 2006 and ending on July 2, 2006, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Indenture. Any determination regarding the right to convert the Notes during any subsequent fiscal quarter shall be made in accordance with the terms of the Indenture. 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making this announcement and a copy of the Notice of the Right to Convert delivered to the holders of the Notes are attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 and Exhibit 99.2, respectively.
