- (1) the reporting person in June 2004 pursuant to former Rule 16b-3; and (iii) the sale of 4,000 shares of Class C Stock; and (on Table II) the partial closing of the June 2005 employee stock option and the closing of the June 2004 employee stock option. The exercises of the June 2004 and June 2005 employee stock options are exempt under Section 16(b) under Rule 16b-6, but are reported herein pursuant to Rule 16a-4.
- (2) The option was exercisable beginning May 31, 2006 with respect to 2,000 shares, beginning May 31, 2007 with respect to 2,000 shares and is exercisable beginning May 31, 2008 with respect to 2,000 shares.
- (3) The option was exercisable beginning May 31, 2005 with respect to 2,000 shares, beginning May 31, 2006 with respect to 2,000 shares and beginning May 31, 2007 with respect to 2,000 shares.
