Cooney a letter indicating that Mr. Cooney does not intend to stand for election to the Company's Board of Directors at the upcoming 2006 Annual Meeting of Shareholders. Mr. Cooney did not express any disagreement with the Company on any matter relating to the Company's operations, policies or practices.

In connection with Mr. Cooney's decision, the Board of Directors reduced the size of the Board from fifteen (15) to fourteen (14) members to be effective at the Company's Annual Meeting of Shareholders.
