(2) 2,000 of such options became exercisable on May 2, 1996 and 2,000 of such options became exercisable on August 28, 1997. In addition, the reporting person was granted 4,000 options which will vest upon the earlier of (i) the date on

which the closing price of the Company's Common Stock has been at least \$50 per share for the previous 20 consecutive trading days or (ii) February 8, 2004. (3) 500 of such options became exercisable on May 2, 1996 and 500 of such options became exercisable on August 28, 1997. In addition, the reporting person was granted 1,000 options which will vest upon the earlier of (i) the date on which the closing price of the Company's Common Stock has been at least \$50 per share for the previous 20 consecutive trading days or (ii) February 10, 2005. (4) Of such options, 3,000 vested on each of May 21, 1999, July 14, 1999 and September 29, 1999.

- (5) Of such options, 12,000 vested on each of May 21, 1999, July 14, 1999 and December 17, 1999.
- (6) Of such options, 3,333 vested on October 1, 2000 and 6,667 will vest upon the earlier of (i) October 1, 2006 or (ii) as to 3,333 of such options, the date on which the closing price of the Company's Common Stock has been at least \$27.40 for 20 consecutive trading days and as to the remaining 3,334 of such options, the date on which the closing price of the Company's Common Stock has been at least \$31.90 for 20 consecutive trading days.
