(1) Vesting of 11,160 restricted stock units exempt pursuant to Rule 16b-3. The restricted stock units were acquired upon payout of 40% (11,160 units) of the earned performance share award under a shareholder-approved benefit plan. The payout was based on the level of achievement of financial targets for the performance period ended September 30, 2013. The restricted stock units were subject to a one-year vesting period. The payout of the other 60% was previously reported.
